GEORGE GREGAN AM

George Gregan AM (born 19 April 1973) is a retired Australian rugby union player and is currently Australia's highest ever internationally capped player. George was born in Lusaka, Zambia and graduated in 1994 with a Bachelor of Education (Physical Education) at the University of Canberra.

George was capped 136 times in Super Rugby for the Brumbies from the inception of that competition in 1996 through 2007, helping to lead them to overall victories in 2001 and 2004. He is a foundation Brumbies player and one of the few players whose career spans both the amateur and professional eras. He was capped 139 times for the Wallabies and his appearances as Australian Captain include a Bledisloe Cup win in 2002 and an extra-time loss to England in the 2003 Rugby World Cup final. As a member of the Wallabies, he has attained the zenith

of the rugby world, winning the Rugby World Cup in 1999. George and his longtime Wallabies teammate, fly-half Stephen Larkham, also hold the all-time record for Test appearances by a halfback partnership with 79. George's other notable achievements are:

- Appointed as a member of the Order of Australia in June 2004 for his services to rugby union in particular as the Wallabies' Captain
- Inducted into the Sport Australia Hall of Fame in 2009
- Inducted into the International Rugby Board Hall of Fame in 2013
- Awarded the University of Canberra Alumni Excellence Award for the Faculty of Education, Science, Technology and Mathematics in 2013.

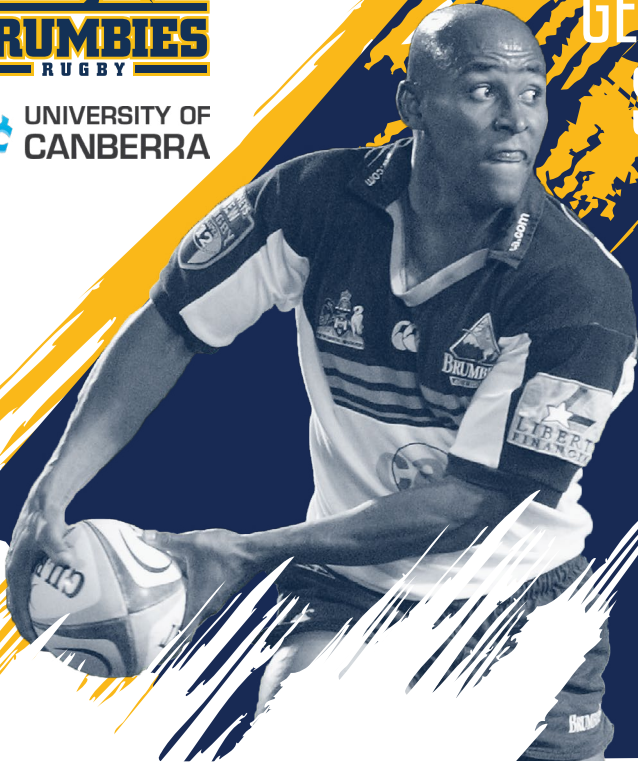

Named in honour of Wallaby and Brumbies great, George Gregan, this prestigious sporting scholarship provides an opportunity for outstanding young rugby union players to pursue their education at the University of Canberra while having their tuition fees waived for subjects passed.

The goal of the scholarship is to prepare the recipients for life beyond professional rugby. They can achieve an internationally recognised degree in the discipline of their choice, while pursuing a pathway through the Brumbies Academy program and playing in Canberra's premier club rugby competition, the John I Dent Cup.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS AND SELECTION

- Australian Citizen
- Accepted into an undergraduate degree at the University of Canberra (not including those offered in conjunction with Ducere Global Business School)
- Selected for the Brumbies Academy program

Note: Selection will be made based on Brumbies Rugby's assessment of the applicant's level of demonstrated potential to succeed at a professional rugby level. Where two or more students are considered equal in the selection process, the applicant's academic achievements will be used for selection.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- Up to five scholarships are available per year.
- Scholarships will cover 100% of recipients' HECS debt and SSAF for subjects passed only.
- Recipients should maintain a minimum of a pass average and adhere to the University of Canberra's undergraduate policies and procedures as at <https://guard.canberra.edu.au/policy/Academic/Progress>.
- Recipients who do not maintain a pass average may have their scholarship withdrawn.
- Recipients must continue in the Brumbies Rugby pathway to a suitable standard at the discretion of Brumbies Academy staff.
- Recipients must agree to be profiled to promote scholarships offered by the University of Canberra.
- Recipients must agree to their academic progress being made known to the scholarship sponsors if required.
- The University will reserve the right to re-allocate the scholarship if for any reason the scholarship is withdrawn.

- EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST ARE DUE BY **FRIDAY 27TH SEPTEMBER 2019** FOR 2020 SCHOLARSHIPS. These will be considered by Brumbies Rugby as soon as possible after this date. Applicants may be asked for additional information where required including Year 11 and 12 school reports and an endorsement letter from a Level 3 Rugby Union coach.
